Enameling involves fusing powdered glass to a metal surface through multiple firings, resulting in a stunning glossy finish. Leave with two beautiful pieces to cherish.

Students will have the opportunity to glaze their pottery pieces and attach them to a charred wood palette for display.

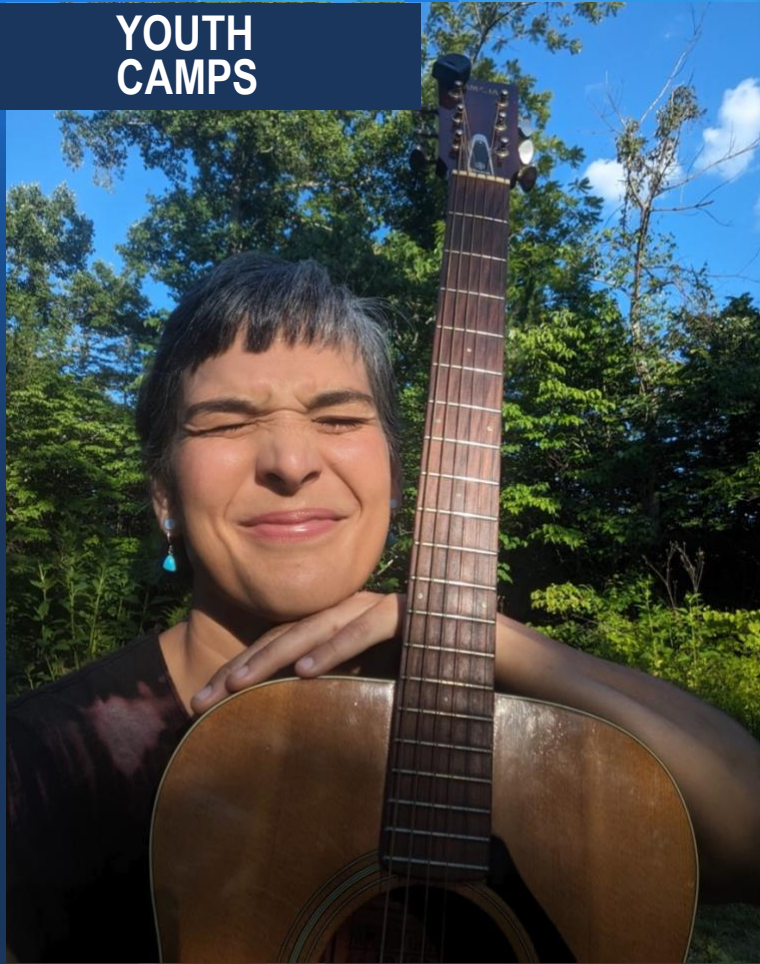

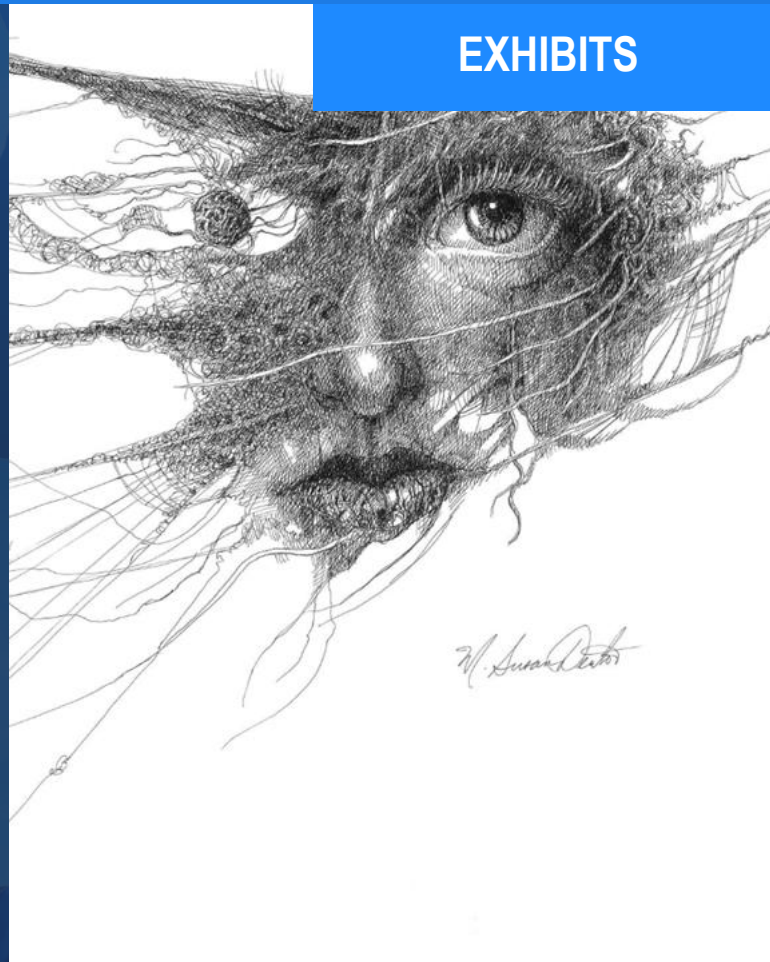

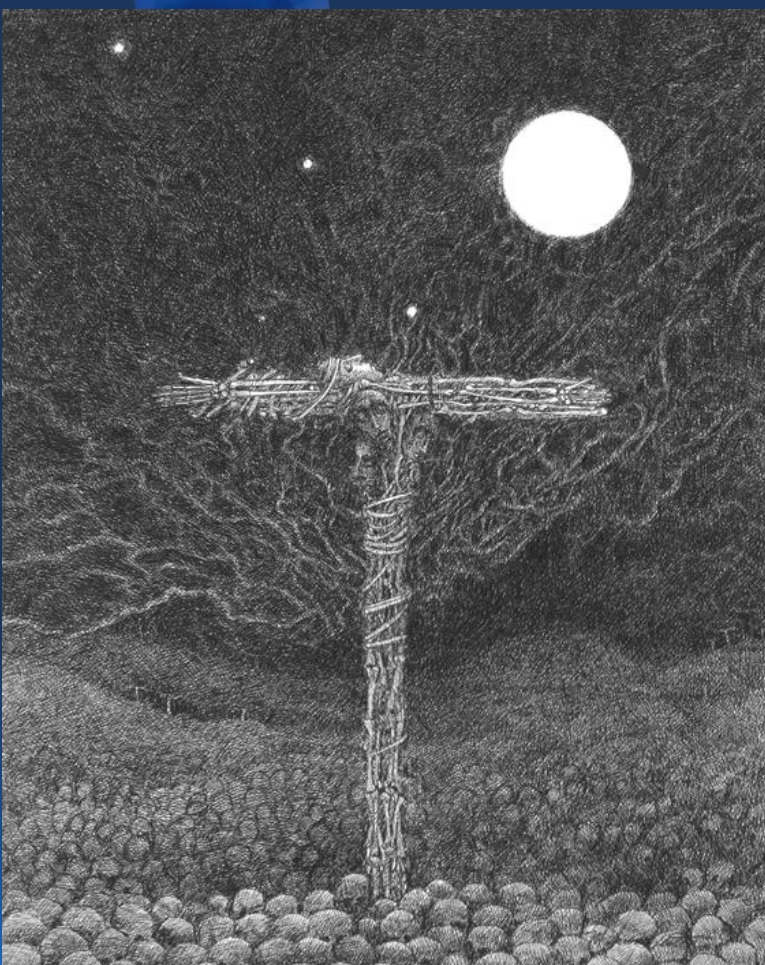
